

Student Accident Coverage Information

Dear Parent:

Because the District is an eligible member of the Prairie State Insurance Cooperative (PSIC), Student Accident Coverage will be provided for each enrolled K-12 student. No special enrollment is necessary for the school time Student Accident Coverage provided through PSIC. This insurance is **accident coverage only** and will not replace your current health insurance as it **pays secondary** to any health policy.

As a member of the PSIC, Student Accident insurance provides coverage for all school district sponsored sports and activities, including tackle football for grades 8-12.

With regard to filing a claim under the district sponsored program which includes all enrolled students you must contact your child's school and complete a Student Accident Claim Form. Please read the Claim Form for complete details on how to submit a claim. You must file a claim with your own health insurance carrier. **The Student Accident plan is designed to pay for expenses which are not reimbursed by your current health insurance.** The school district and medical/dental providers are not responsible for filing a student accident claim.
