## **Alternative Learning Days Special Services FAQ**

- 1. My child's IEP meeting is due or scheduled during the time that school is closed, will we have the meeting?
  - a. You will be contacted by a staff member regarding your child's meeting.
  - b. If your meeting due date is **after** the proposed return to school, you can elect to reschedule for a date when school is back in session or you may elect to participate in the IEP meeting by video or phone conference.
  - c. If your meeting due date is **during** the school closure, we must complete the meeting by phone or video conference.
- 2. My child has related services (speech, social work, OT, PT) listed on his/her IEP. Will those services be provided?
  - a. An alternative form of those services will be provided. In other words, your child will be provided a level of service based on what can feasibly be provided through the alternative learning format. This will include:
    - i. Selecting from a menu of activities the student can complete on his/her own or with a parent. The menu of items will be given by your related service provider. This could be in paper or online format.
    - ii. Check-ins from the service provider by email, phone, or video chat
  - b. Should you have further questions about related services, please contact your service provider or the special education coordinator at 309-945-0447
- 3. Will my child receive the instruction, accommodations, and modifications as listed on the IEP?
  - a. Instruction, accommodations and modifications will be provided to the best of our ability and as needed in the alternative learning environment, but will not look exactly the same as they do when school is in session.
- 4. Which activities should my child complete?
  - a. Complete the general education activities for those classes for which your student attends general education.
  - b. Complete special education activities as directed by your student's primary special education teacher (case manager).
- 5. My child is having difficulty completing an activity, what should I do?
  - a. Please contact your child's primary special education teacher regarding your concern. The teacher will guide you in accommodating or modifying the assignment or selecting a different assignment.
