FLU SHOTS

Geneseo CUSD #228 Health Plan participants can use the convenience of a pharmacy to receive your annual flu vaccination. The network pharmacy will use the information on your health plan ID card to cover the cost of the vaccine.

To lower your chances of getting the flu, The Center for Disease Control (CDC) recommends getting vaccinated in October.

Where can I get a flu vaccination?

To have the flu vaccine covered by the health plan, you need to use a participating pharmacy. Most chain and independent pharmacies are part of the BlueCross BlueShield Pharmacy Network.
